Motivated by the Sandy Hook shooting, this course will provide bystanders with the knowledge and hands on training to assist in a bleeding emergency before professional help arrives. The Stop the Bleed course is intended for high school students, teachers and staff.

Time: 1 Hour (Includes a 15-minute presentation followed by hands on training with Stop the Bleed equipment)

Cost: Free



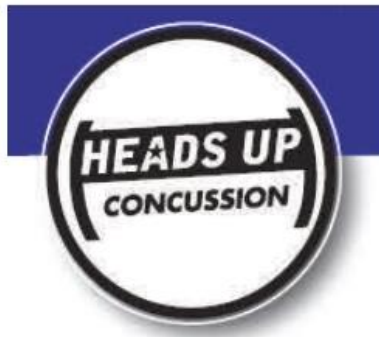
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Heads up concussion training was developed by the Center for Disease control to recognize, respond to and minimize the risk of a concussion or other serious brain injury. This training can provide parents, teachers, coaches and students the ability to recognize the signs and symptoms of a concussion. Concussion goggles are used to simulate the effects of a concussion and can be used on all participants of the course.

Time: 1 Hour (Includes presentation and hands on experience)

Cost: Free



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This program uses, “What do you consider lethal?” as a startling question to jumpstart the discussion about reckless and distracted driving. This is an educational program designed to save the lives of teen drivers and passengers. The program is better conducted in smaller groups to engage discussions.
